Thank you for your letter dated August 27, 2009, regarding Oak Ridge Land Company, LLC's compliance with Agreed Order #05-0249.

The final Agreed Order was approved by the Water Quality Control Board on May 23, 2006. A copy of the order is enclosed with this response. This Order was issued prior to our enforcement database development and so is not available online on our department website.

My staff conducted a site inspection on August 28, 2009, and observed that although there were areas on-site in need of stabilization, no sediment loss was noted off-site. The Respondent had successfully completed corrective actions and restoration on the unnamed tributary to Roberts Branch.

The division contacted the Respondent, Mr. Consorto, who immediately took action to stabilize the areas on-site. Mr. Consorto re-established BMPs along Rarity Ridge Parkway, laid geo-tech fabric, and hydro-seeded bare areas at the site.

Mr. Consorto also completed the Level 1 TDEC Erosion Prevention Sediment Control course requirement on June 19, 2007. An updated EPSC Level I Certification Listing is available at the following link: <http://www.tnepsc.org/>.

At the time of the inspection, division personnel did observe large amounts of sediment released into the headwaters of the unnamed tributary to Roberts Branch upstream of

Rarity Ridge. After further investigation, the sediment releases were found to be coming from a disturbed dirt road between two lots on Lawnville Road. A Notice of Violation has been issued to that landowner.
